

REPORT OF STATE LEVEL WORKSHOP

A state level workshop sponsored by the UGC under the XII plan was organized by the Dept. of English in Christ College, Cuttack. The topic of this workshop was "The Portrayal of Women characters in Indian English Literature". It was organized on Tuesday, the 21st of Feb. 2017.

These were an august gathering consisting of many Professors from various other colleges like Ravenshaw University, Stewart Science College. Women's College, Imarti Devi College and Indira Gandhi College. It was also attended by the members of the Governing Body of the College.

The Workshop was declared open by the Principal, Mr. Manmath Kumar Otta, at 11.30 a.m with a welcome address. Flower bouquets were offered to the dignitaries on the dais by the students of the Dept. of the English followed by a melodious welcome song. The paper attempted to establish as major literary maestro of both genres and to analyse the theme of the emancipated woman.
